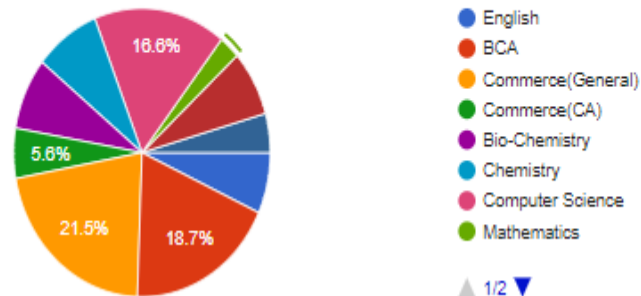

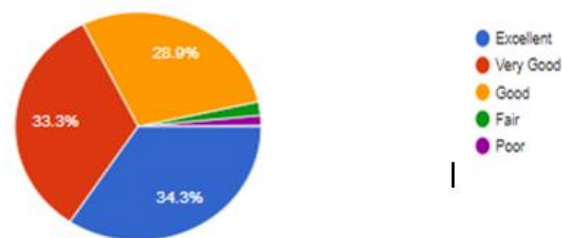

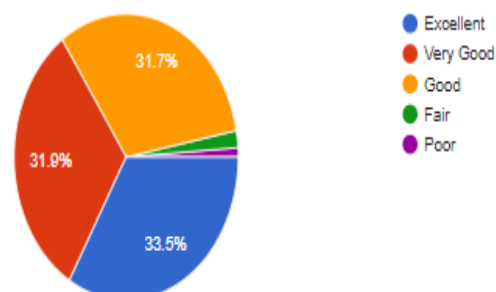

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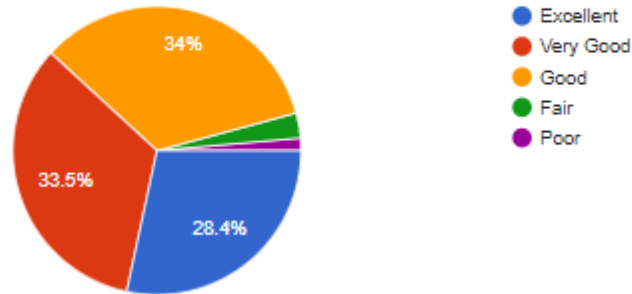




3. How much syllabus was covered in the class?

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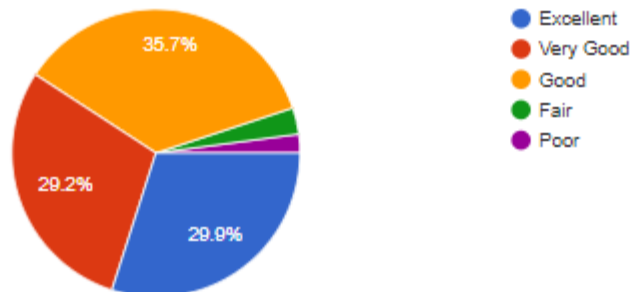

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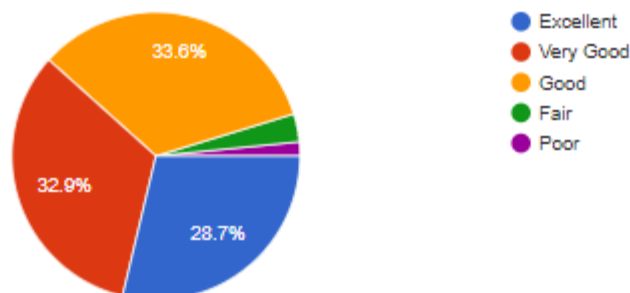

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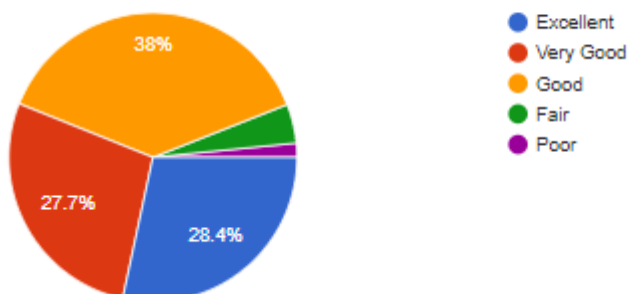




7. Fairness of the Internal Evaluation by the teachers.

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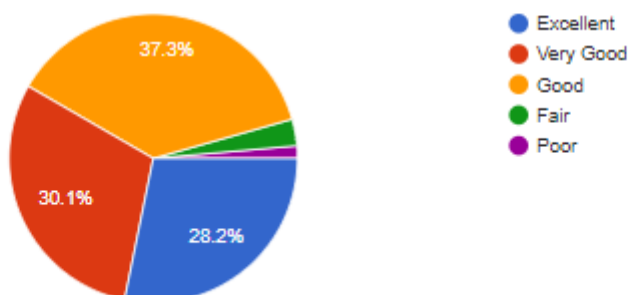

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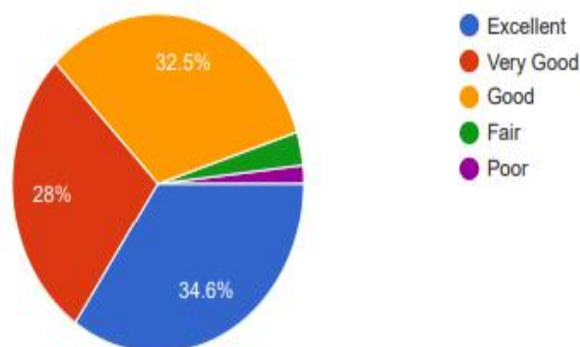

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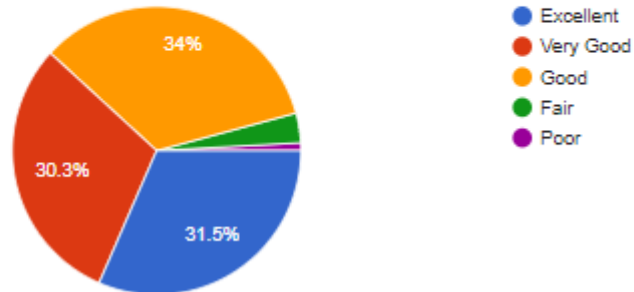

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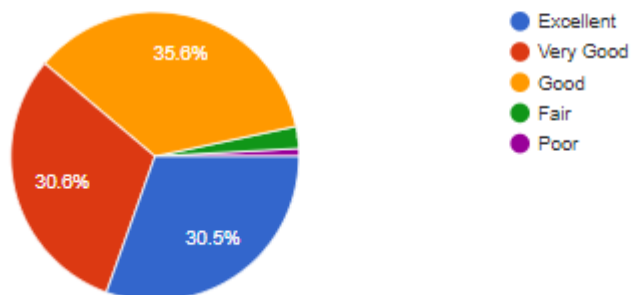

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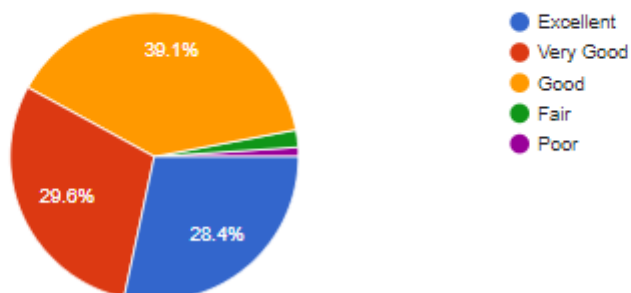

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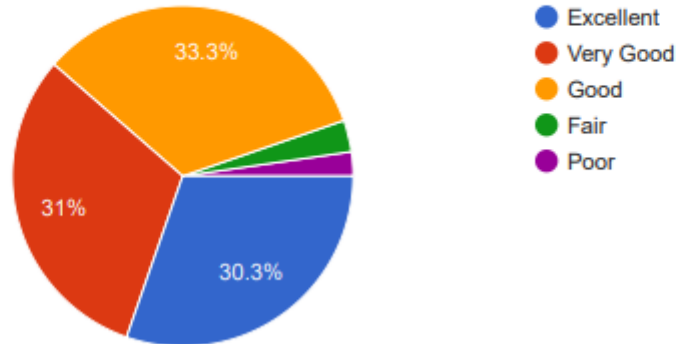

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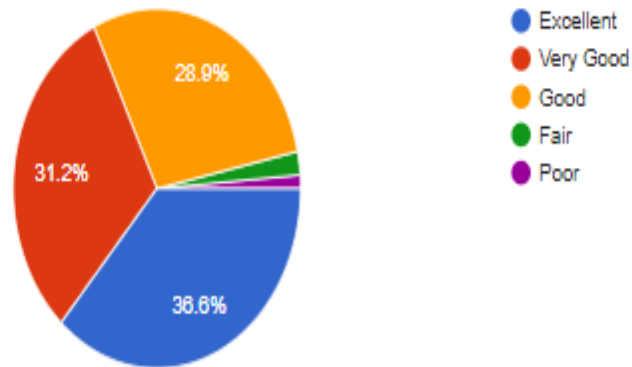

STUDENTS SATISFACTORY SURVEY 2022 - 2023

SUMMARY:

The Analysis of the Students Satisfactory survey 2022 - 2023 reveal that

- 61.9% students agreed that 85 - 100% of the syllabus is covered in the class.
- Majority of students agree that teachers have good communication skills.
- 62.3% of students related that teachers come "Thoroughly" prepared for the class and 48.7% rated the preparation of teachers "Satisfactory". Students agree that teachers illustrate concepts through examples and Applications.
- 46.9% say that 75% teachers use ICT tools such as LCD Projector, Multimedia etc., while teaching.
- Majority of the students 67.5% feel the teachers are "Always Fair" towards Internal Evaluation. 65.7% agreed that their performance is assignments and discussed.
- 67.4% agree to a great extent the college/teachers use student centric methods. such as experimental learning, and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.
- Majority of the students feel that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.
- 62% strongly agree that the college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.
- Majority of the students feel that the teachers excellent approach towards teaching.
- 57.8% students agree that the college/teachers take efforts to inculcate soft skill.
- 57.6% students feel that the teaching and the mentoring process in the college facilitates cognitive, social and emotional growth while 61.3% say that life skills and employability skills make them ready for the world of work.
- 67.3% rate the overall quality of teaching - learning process in the college as "Very Good".
