The college adheres to the policy and norms for Research Promotion and Code of Ethics in Research established by Thiruvalluvar University. Additionally, Sri Akilandeswari Women's College has developed its own research policy to provide a comprehensive framework for the faculty and scholars across all research departments.

## **Objectives:**

- Improve Research Quality: Enhance the quality of research among faculty members and scholars.
- Ensure Integrity and Ethics: Uphold high standards of quality, integrity, and ethics in research.
- Promote High-Impact Publications: Ensure publications are in UGC CARE listed, Scopus indexed, or Web of Science journals with high impact factors.
- Encourage Conference Participation: Motivate faculty members to participate in and present papers at international, national, and state-level conferences and symposiums.
- Conduct Doctoral Committee Meetings: Hold Doctoral Committee meetings periodically to review research progress.

- Organize Workshops and Seminars: Conduct international, national, and state-level workshops, seminars, and enhancement programs on research methodology, academic writing, and intellectual property rights to foster improved research and publications in reputed journals.
- Access to E-Library and N-LIST: Ensure that all faculty and research scholars have access to the e-library and explore N-LIST: National Library and Information Services.
- Secure Research Funding: Explore and obtain research funding from private and government-based support systems.
- Create VIDWAN ID: Provide a VIDWAN ID for all faculty members to enhance their professional profiles on a sophisticated web interface.
- Support IQAC: Assist the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in generating reports on various research assessments of research supervisors and scholars.
- Research Forum: Maintain a Research Forum comprising research scholars from all departments to address issues related to research.
- This comprehensive policy aims to foster a robust research culture within the college, ensuring that all research activities are conducted with the highest standards of quality, integrity, and ethical consideration.
